The Peter Lynn Bomba

As the Bomba can hold smooth power and pivots on the tip in the turns, this makes it a superb kite for the waves and wakestyle riders. This new design makes unhooked moves possible. Amazing pop from simply loading the rail will suit low level and technical maneuvers.

The slightly increased profile thickness improves water relaunch and makes the kite stable and forgiving, perfect for beginners. The great amount of depower allows these riders to get going in gusty conditions.

Flying characteristics

Fast water relaunch

The lower aspect ratio and deeper profiles combined with the new improved tip design drastically improve the water relaunch!

Easy to setup

No need to pump, the kite inflates itself!
After kiteboarding the deflating zipper lets you pack up fast and easy.

Quick turning speed

The extra rear line webbing causes a faster turning kite. This better manoeverability is very good for waveriding.

Personal bar pressure

You can easily set the pressure on the bar. Choose from the two settings to get the kite response that you prefer.

Stability

Extremely stable like all the Peter Lynn Twinskin kites. The kite doesn't luff, proven to be ideal for learning the sport!

De-power

The Bomba now features more depower for more comfort on the water, especially in gusty conditions.



Safety

Please note that the bar supplied with the Bomba is equipped with a quick release depower loop, safety leash with quick release and there is a quick release on the big harness line. When the safety system is activated, the kite immediately loses all its power and gently falls down on the water. Because the Bomba has no rigid leading edge, the kite stays on the water until the rider is ready to carry on kiteboarding and grabs the bar.





Twin Skin Technology

The Bomba is Peter Lynn Twin Skin kite. The kite consists of two layers of fabric with a set of profiles in between.

Some of the great advantages of this style of kite are:

Very clean airflow around the wing, both the top skin and the bottom skin are shaped for maximum performance.

No bladders or tubes that can burst, the kite is more resistant to wear & tear.

Even weight distribution as the complete kite is made of the same material. This makes the kite incredibly stable. No heavy leading edge causing the kite to luff.

Easy repairs as the material is all solid Chikara Ripstop Nylon.

New features

New improved profile for a high performance while still keeping the TwinSkin extreme stability.

New tip design for easy water relaunch and virtually no chance of lines getting caught around the tips.

Trailing edge webbing for more direct steering and more depower.

Deflation zipper for even easier deflation while packing up.

Foldable spars for easy transport and storage.

Expandable backpack for the choice of leaving the spars in the kite or taking them out.


